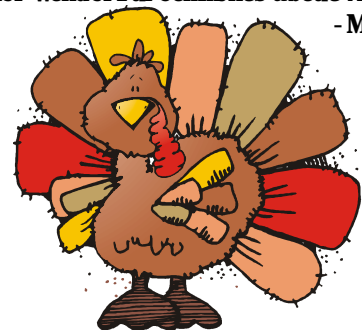
### From the Director
