Most denture-wearers hate their dentures. That is partly true. A denture that replaces the upper teeth usually stays in fairly well. It's the lower denture that just floats around. The lower denture-wearer learns to keep the denture in with their tongue somehow. An unstable denture makes eating difficult and causes mouth sores.

Dental implants have revolutionized the

lower denture. Implants have been around since the 1960s. When most people hear "dental implants" they think expensive. Recently in the last few years the implant industry has been able to simplify the implant which has cut the cost by half. People who previously couldn't afford dental implants are now becoming more interested in them.

What dental implants do is allow the denture wearer to **eat confidently, speak easier, and wear the denture more comfortably.** With dental implants there is no need for denture adhesives. The dentures literally snap in place. Dental implants help avoid embarrassing social situations.

The long-term benefit is that they **preserve the jaw bone.** When a tooth is lost, the bone around the tooth no longer has forces applied to it, so it melts away. The implant helps transfer the chewing forces to the jaw bone, which preserves the bone like a natural tooth would.

With better chewing ability, implant-supported denture-wearers **enjoy a healthier, more nutritious diet.** They can enjoy the foods they had been avoiding, such as raw fruits and vegetables, steak, corn-on-the-cob.

The procedure is simple and quick. In **one appointment** I place the implants and fit them to the denture. Any discomfort is taken care of with over-the-counter pain relievers. If your dentures aren't in good shape, then additional appointments would be required.

Why put up with the embarrassment, poor chewing ability, and sores any longer? **Call for a quick consult** to see if you or a family member would be a good candidate for an implant-supported denture.
