**D**uring high school I was enjoying a leisure activity with friends when a sudden turn of events resulted in breaking my two front teeth. The trauma to my mouth and to my ego was soon soothed by two new caps. Over time, the metal base started showing at the top of my front teeth, so I decided to find out what my options were.

My husband John and I are in the video production business, so a good presentation—in film or in person—is important to us. John had previously had cosmetic work done on his teeth. While they looked great—a look I wanted to achieve—they didn't fit well and were uncomfortable. I decided to find another dentist.
