# Occlusal Therapy

## Defining Occlusal Conditions

- **Primary Occlusal Trauma**
  - Excessive force with normal support
    - Heavy contacts, prematurities, habits
- **Secondary Occlusal Trauma**
  - Normal force with reduced support
    - Lost support of periodontal disease or short roots
