

POST-OP INSTRUCTIONS FOR ROOT CANAL THERAPY

The following information has been prepared to help answer the many questions you may have regarding the procedure which has just been performed. Please read the instructions carefully. Our experience has shown them to be very helpful.

1. It is typical to experience some soreness after the root canal treatment. This should start easing off in a few days. If you are able to take Advil/Motrin or the equivalent, take 3/200mg tabs 3 times a day to help reduce inflammation or soreness.
2. You may have a temporary filling in your tooth for now. It is very important that you reschedule for a permanent restoration as soon as possible. Your tooth is in a fragile state after a root canal has been performed and if you choose to use it as normal then you take a risk in breaking and/or losing the tooth.
