As part of that commitment we attempt to obtain the maximum insurance coverage allowed by your dental insurance plan for treatment received. We encourage all patients to fully know and understand their insurance coverage. The plan documents can usually be obtained by reviewing your plan documents provided by your employer or by calling your insurance company directly.

General insurance information important for you to know:

1. **Quotes of your ESTIMATED insurance benefit are to be considered a GUIDELINE ONLY.** We cannot be responsible for knowing all the factors your insurance company will consider when processing the claim for your treatment. All charges are your responsibility whether your insurance pays or does not pay. Not all services covered benefit on all plans. When final payment is received, your account will be reconciled. _____ (Initials)

2. For patients with dual insurance coverage, *only* the primary insurance will be factored into the original treatment financials. Once the primary insurance begins paying on the treatment, we are then able to file with your secondary plan. Account adjustments will be made when both insurances have finished paying their portion of the treatment cost. _____ (Initials)

3. It is very important to let our office know if your insurance coverage **changes** in any way over the course of treatment. Changes in your insurance provider or dental benefit can affect the amount received on your treatment. _____ (Initials)

4. We encourage you to closely examine your insurance Explanation of Benefits as payments are made on your treatment. Should you have questions regarding the payments by your insurance company, we encourage you to contact your insurance provider or our office at 210-492-8335. _____ (Initials)

5. If you plan to obtain reimbursement from your Flexible Spending Account, our office can supply, upon request, standard documentation regarding treatment and payment which will be sufficient for most Flex Plans. It is your responsibility to work with your plan administrator for reimbursement. Due to diversity of these plans, the practice cannot be responsible for information regarding how your plan works. It is imperative that you reply on the Flex Spend administrator to help in this area. _____ (Initials)
