A connection between Fosamax and other bisphosphonates with a serious bone disease called Osteonecrosis of the Jaw (ONJ) has been found.

Biphosphonates are commonly used in tablet form to prevent and treat osteoporosis in post-menopausal women. They are also used in the treatment of Paget's disease. Stronger forms given orally or intravenously (IV) are commonly used in the management of advanced cancers including, but not limited to lung cancer, breast cancer, prostate cancer & multiple myeloma.
