## DR. STEVEN JACKSON IS RETIRING



After 33 years of full-time ophthalmology service in the Salt Lake Valley, Steven T. Jackson, M.D. is retiring. Dr. Jackson received his B.S. Degree from BYU and his M.D. Degree from the University of Utah. He obtained his ophthalmology training at UCLA and

fellowship training in eyelid, facial, orbital, and lacrimal (tear duct) system at Emory University (Atlanta).

Dr. Jackson started his ophthalmology practice "from scratch" as a sole practitioner with one receptionist/secretary/assistant who did everything else. His first location was at 5801 South 300 East, Murray. After ten years he outgrew the office space and moved to the present location at 201 East 5900 South, where the practice has grown to six doctors and eight other staff members.

Dr. Jackson is a fellow of the American Academy of Ophthalmology and of the American Society of Ophthalmic Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery. He is an Associate Professor of Ophthalmology at the University of Utah. He has served two separate three-year terms as Chairman of Ophthalmology at Cottonwood Hospital, and was President of the Utah Ophthalmology Society.

His greatest joy and satisfaction over these many years has been helping thousands of patients with their eye and vision problems, and the close association with patients, doctors and an outstanding staff. He will deeply miss this work and interaction in his life, but is looking forward to many more years of service in the community and church. He is hoping to spend more time with his family and with hobbies and activities he enjoys.
