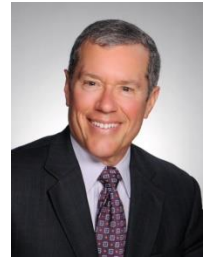

Restorative Materials- “Why Does This Have To Be So Confusing?”
*Presenter: Charles Wakefield, DDS***

Course Description: This full day lecture will review the current confusing array of restorative materials and clarify the rationale for the selection and clinical use of the most appropriate material in varying clinical situations. The confusion between marketing and evidence-based dentistry will be made clear. Review and updates on composites, bulk cure technique, core materials, light curing, adhesives, glass ionomers, xerostomia and biocompatibility of materials will be discussed in detail. Clinical use in geriatrics, cancer, dry mouth, bisphosphonate use and normal situations will be expanded and illustrated with clinical cases.



Course Objectives: At the conclusion of this course, attendees will be able to:

1. Understand dental needs of aging baby boomers and modifications necessary due to medical conditions
2. Select the appropriate materials to stock in each practice based on unique patient population
3. Select the best light curing equipment and curing methods for restorative materials
4. Understand the clinical needs of different populations in each practice to customize treatment planning, care and maintenance
5. Know the advantages and disadvantages of each restorative material, including new concepts such as bioactivity, bulk placement and treatment of xerostomia

Dr. Charles Wakefield attended UCLA School of Dentistry and completed a two year AEGD Residency during his 21 year US Army career. He is Board Certified by the Federal Services and American Boards of General Dentistry and is a Fellow of the American and International Colleges of Dentistry. He has been the Director of AEGD programs at Fort Benning, Georgia; Fort Hood, Texas and Medical University of South Carolina. He holds the Surgeon General’s “A” designator and is an Adjunct Professor of Comprehensive Dentistry at the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences and was a tenured Professor and Director of the AEGD Residency Program at Texas A & M College of Dentistry, Dallas, Texas from 1995-2015. Currently, he is in private practice in Lewisville, Texas with his son, Brian Wakefield, DDS, FAGD.

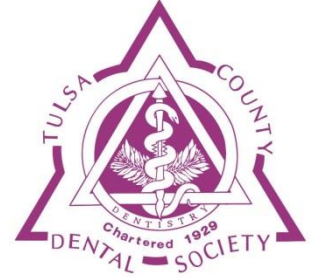
