

WHY IS A REFRACTION IMPORTANT?

A refraction is an important part of your annual eye health examination with Dr. Delianides. The refraction is a procedure that consists of the technician or doctor placing different optical lenses in front of your eyes to determine your prescription for eyeglasses or contact lenses. It is also used to indicate if your eyes are healthy and functioning properly. It is always a good idea to have a current prescription on file in case you lose or damage your eyewear. Eyeglass prescriptions expire within one year. Even a slight prescription change can help you achieve 20/20 vision. Replacing scratched or peeling lenses will aid in restoring clarity to your vision. We participate with Vision Service Plan (VSP) for routine eye exams. VSP covers the exam and refraction under a plan specified co-pay. If you do not have VSP and would like a refraction performed, it is considered a non-covered service by your medical insurance.

The refraction is deemed a non-covered routine service through most medical insurances, including Medicare, Medicaid and other supplemental plans. The cost of a refraction is \$38.00, due at the time of service. If your medical insurance does cover this test, you will be refunded once they have provided payment.

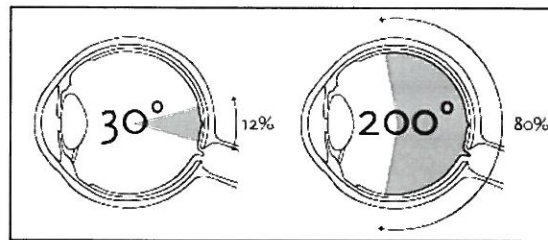

With Optos Retinal Exam

An annual screening of the retina is critical to ensure your eye is healthy. The Optos Retinal Exam is a quick and painless procedure that allows the doctor to see a panoramic view of the retina without the use of dilation drops. This can lead to early detection of common diseases, such as glaucoma, diabetes, hypertension, macular degeneration, retinal detachment, holes or tears and/or possibly cancer. The Optos also serves as a diagnostic tool to provide a baseline retinal image that can be compared annually to prevent eye diseases or future damage to the retina. The Optos Retinal screening is not covered by insurance at this time. The cost for this procedure is \$40.00 due at the time of service.
